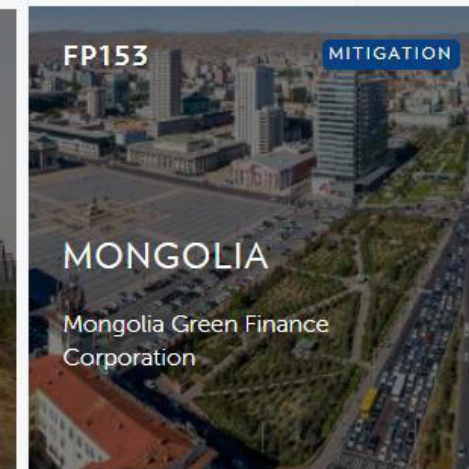
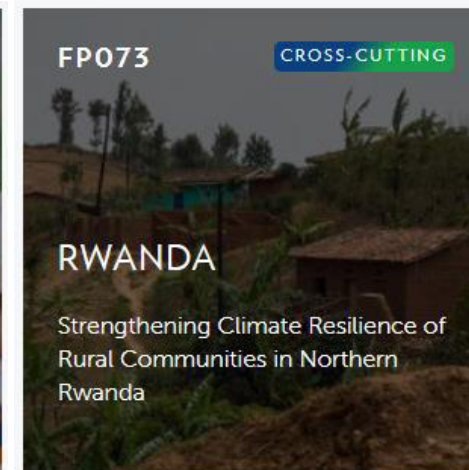
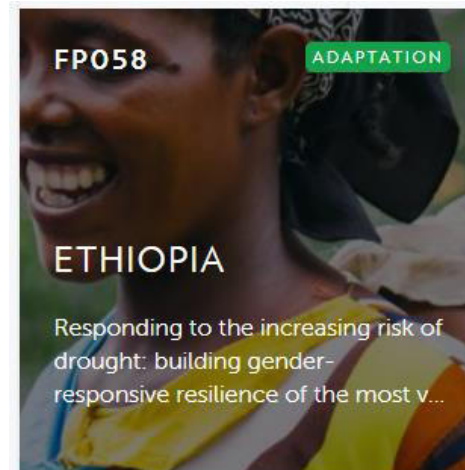


Support for GCF funding proposal development

For countries to access climate finance from the Green Climate Fund (GCF), the Global Green Growth Institute (GGGI) support building institutional capacity and development of funding proposals, five of which have already been approved (for Ethiopia, Fiji, Indonesia, Mongolia and Rwanda), two in the GCF pipeline (for Peru and Senegal), and one being developed (for Indonesia). GGGI has also developed over 20 concept notes submitted for Cambodia, Cote d'Ivoire, Fiji, Guyana, Indonesia, Jordan, Lao PDR, Nepal, Philippines, Rwanda and Vanuatu. In most of these projects, GGGI works with national direct access entities. The total value of these projects is estimated at USD 2.4 billion, of which GCF contribution is at USD 1.1 billion.



GGGI supports **national** direct access entities on funding proposal development to access GCF funding: USD 143 million approved, with Ethiopia's Ministry of Finance and Economic Cooperation; Rwanda's Ministry of Environment; Fiji Development Bank; Mongolia's XacBank LLC
