Fiji's Key Development Challenges

- Vulnerability to external shocks, including climate disasters and financial crises
- High dependence on imported fossil fuels
- Declining terrestrial and marine biodiversity due to unsustainable land management and coral reef degradation
- High cost of provisions of infrastructure and services in urban and rural communities



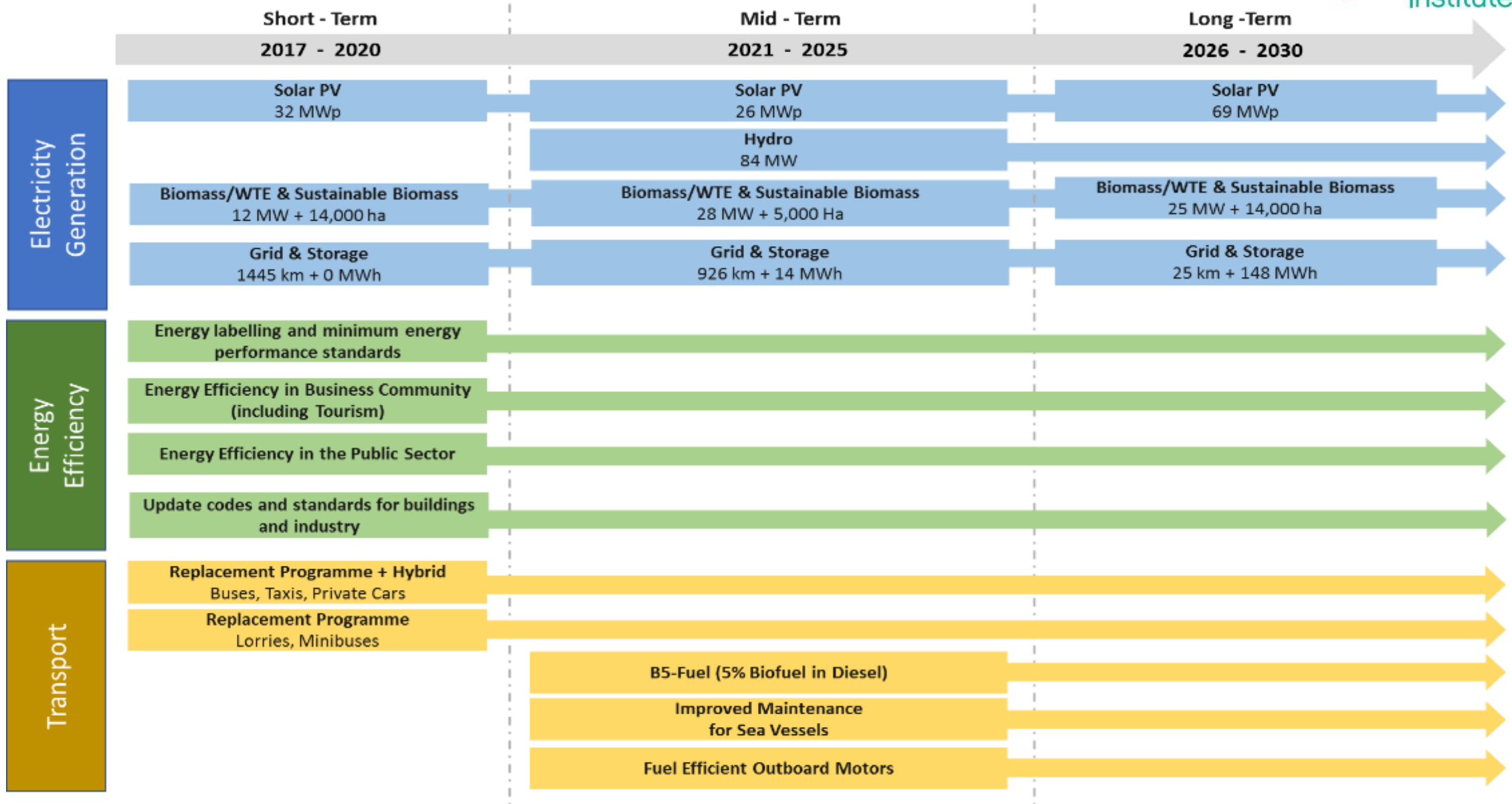
Fiji's Green Growth Pathways



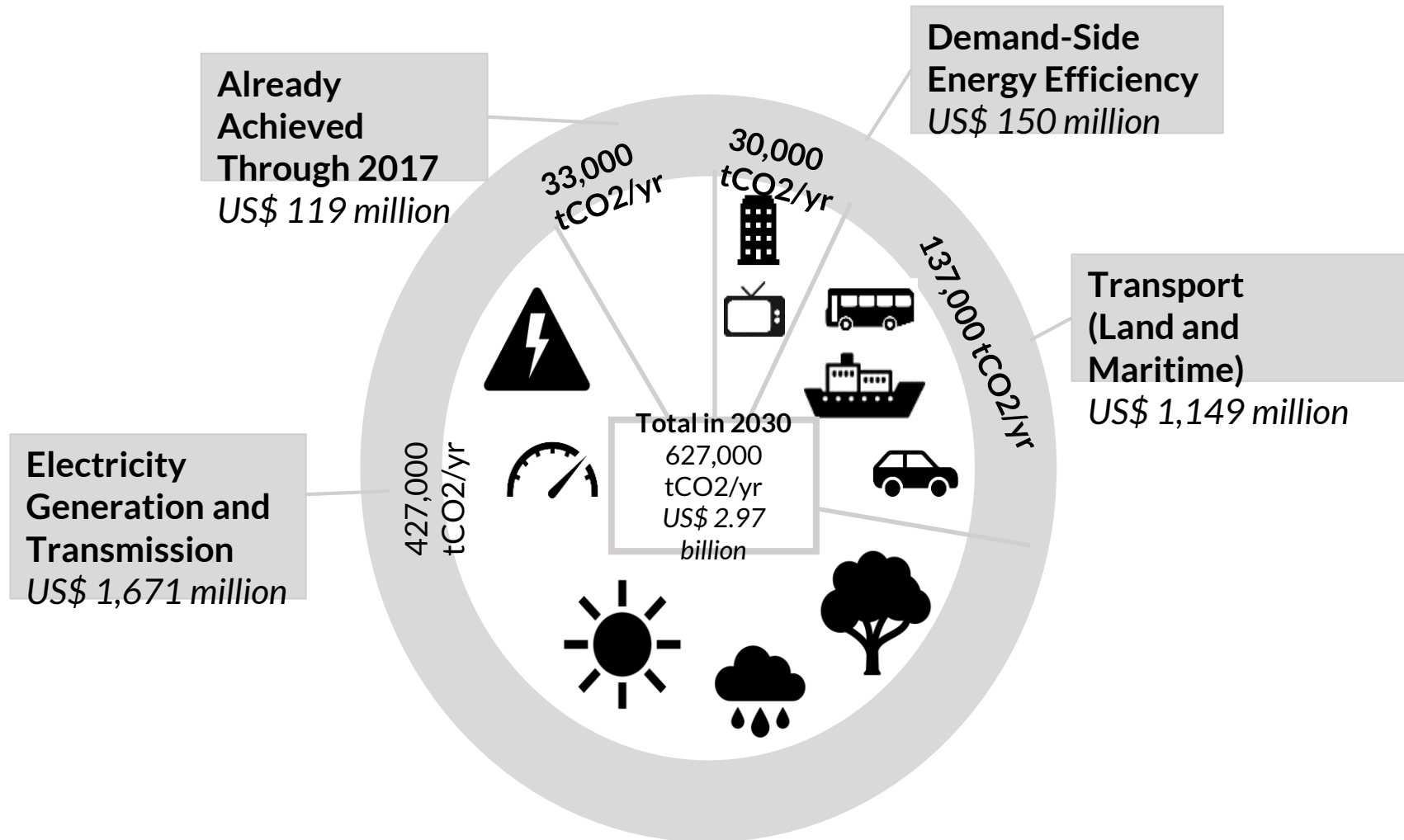
- A Green Growth Framework for Fiji was established in 2014
- Fiji became a member of GGGI in April 2014
- The Government of Fiji (GOF) is committed to fighting climate change by demonstrating ambitious actions
 - NDC target of reducing 30% of GHG emission
 - 100% Renewable electricity generation
 - NDC Implementation Roadmap launch in 2017.
 - Presidency of the 23rd UNFCCC Conference of the Parties (COP) 2017



Implementation Plan



Actions are under way



- Fiji has invested at least US\$ **119m in mitigation in the energy sector (2014 – 2017)**
- **Tax incentives** to support energy sector investments
- Ministry of Economy, Reserve Bank of Fiji, and the International Finance Corporation are launching a **US\$ 100m “Green Bond”**.
- Direct access to the Green Climate Fund secured via the Fiji Development Bank
