



Interim disclosure policy

The Global Green Growth Institute (“the GGGI”) shall operate in a transparent and accountable manner. The GGGI shall publically disclose information concerning its decisions and operational activities in the absence of a compelling reason to consider such information confidential, as to be determined by the Director-General.

Pending a decision to adopt a comprehensive disclosure policy, which ensures transparency of the work of the GGGI, this document shall serve as the interim disclosure policy (the “Interim Disclosure Policy”).

Under this interim disclosure policy, the following records shall be posted on the GGGI’s web site or made available upon request, as and when they are developed and become available, except in cases where disclosure is restricted due to confidentiality:

1. The discussions, decisions and documents received, reviewed and adopted by the Assembly, except recordings of meetings held in closed session;
2. The criteria on which non-state entities are granted Observer status;
3. The discussions, decisions and related documents in the Council, except recordings of meetings held in closed session;
4. The criteria on which experts and non-state actors in the Council are selected;
5. The criteria and methodology for country program selection;
6. The criteria on which the members of the Advisory Committee are approved;
7. The GGGI’s annual audited financial statements;
8. The GGGI’s rules and procedures, including Rules of Procedure of the Assembly, Council, Advisory Committee and subsidiary bodies;
9. List of current participants in all of the GGGI’s statutory organs; and,
10. Major procurement solicitation notices issued, and name of vendor and contract amount awarded.

This Interim Disclosure Policy shall remain in effect until such time as it is superseded by a comprehensive disclosure policy.
