The Establishment Agreement establishes the function of the Council to establish objective criteria for country programming (Art. 8.5.f.). The MPSC agreed at its Ninth meeting that GGGI would benefit from articulating clear criteria for country program selection and definition of value proposition for Member, including those that do not have a country program, and Partner countries. Such criteria did not previously exist as operations were almost entirely funded with core resources through the Work Program and Budget (WPB).
