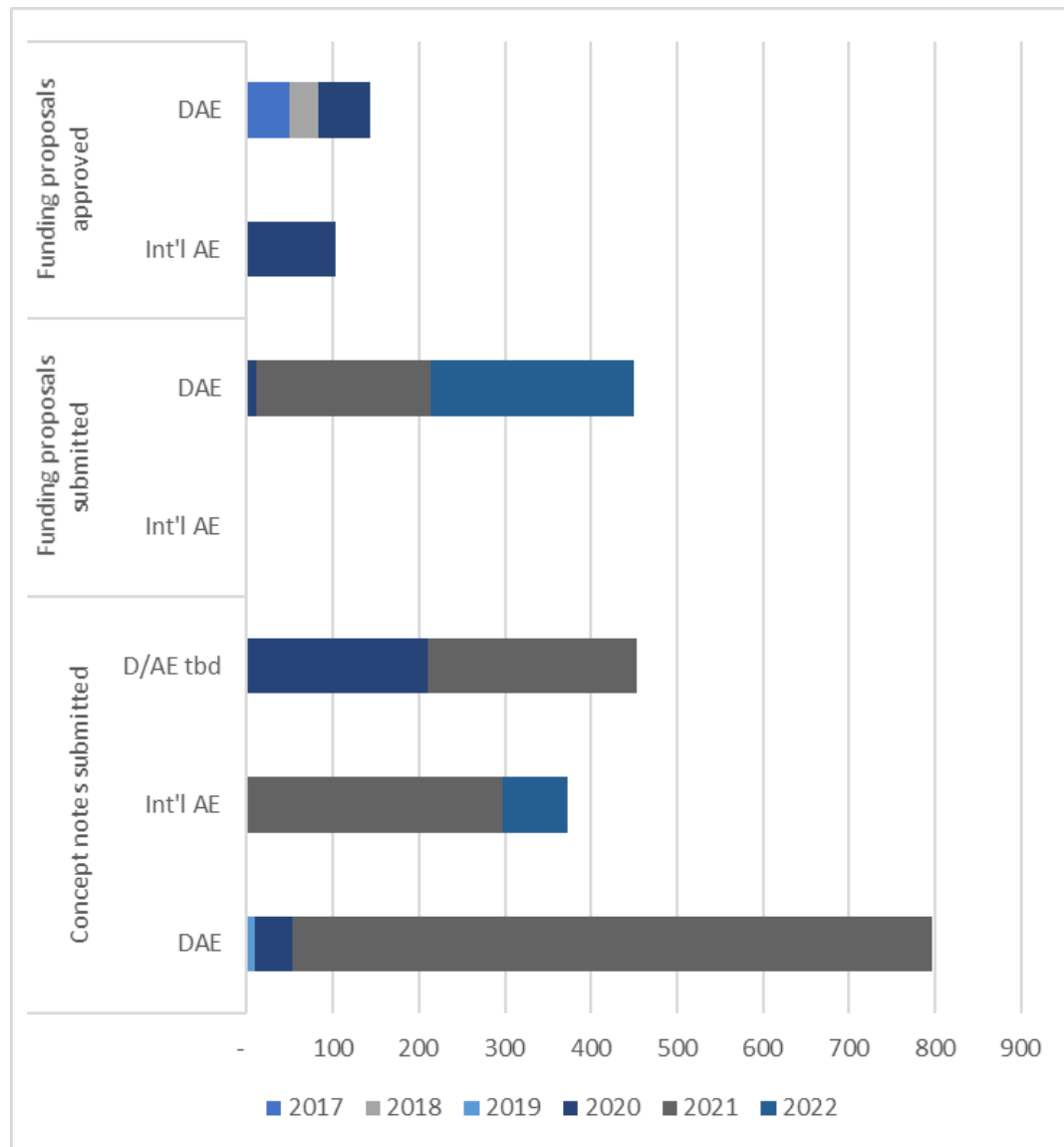
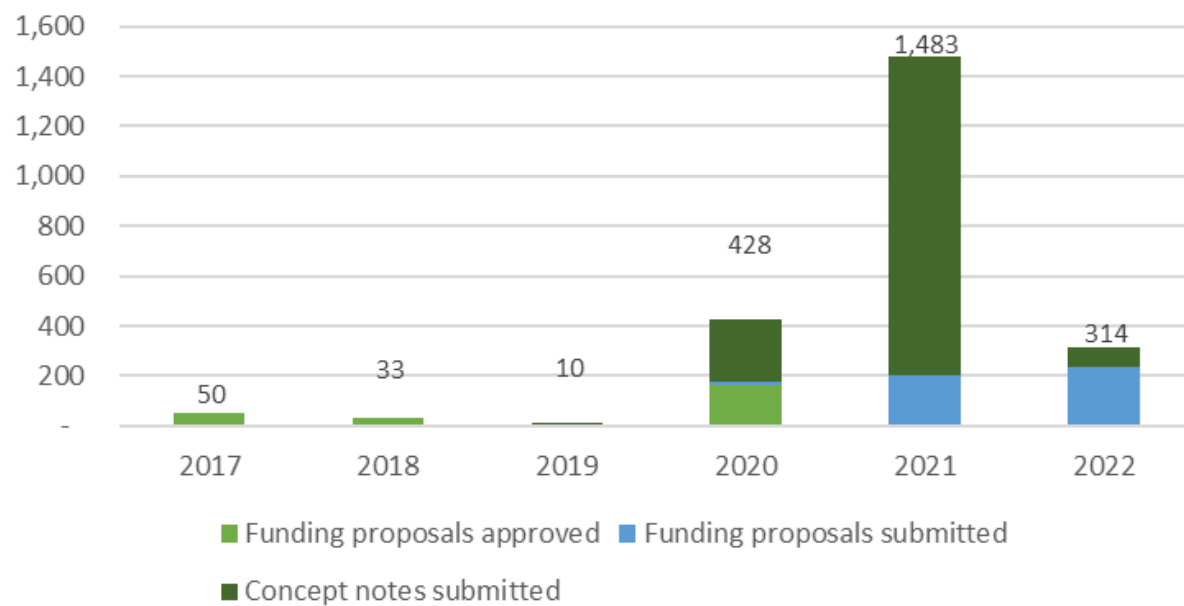

GGGI-GCF Partnership



- As part of its mandate, GGGI helped mobilize over USD7 billion in green investments and climate finance in developing countries. GGGI has done so by supporting countries to tap into finance from diverse sources, including bilateral aid, multilateral development banks, and the private sector. One critical source of climate finance is the Green Climate Fund (GCF).
- GGGI and GCF signed a Framework Readiness and Preparatory Support Grant Agreement in 2017. Under this strategic partnership, GGGI acts as the Readiness Delivery Partner and supports its member countries to access GCF financing.
- GGGI supports national designated authorities (NDAs) and existing and potential national direct access entities (DAEs) to develop projects for submission to GCF and to access Readiness Programme resources. GGGI also works with partner governments to develop concept notes and funding proposals for submission to GCF.
- 30 countries have requested GGGI as Readiness Delivery Partner. GGGI supported 26 of our government partners to access over USD 34 million in GCF approved Readiness funding and in addition, submitted over USD 17 million Readiness proposals.

Support in Mobilizing Green Investment, USD2.3 billion

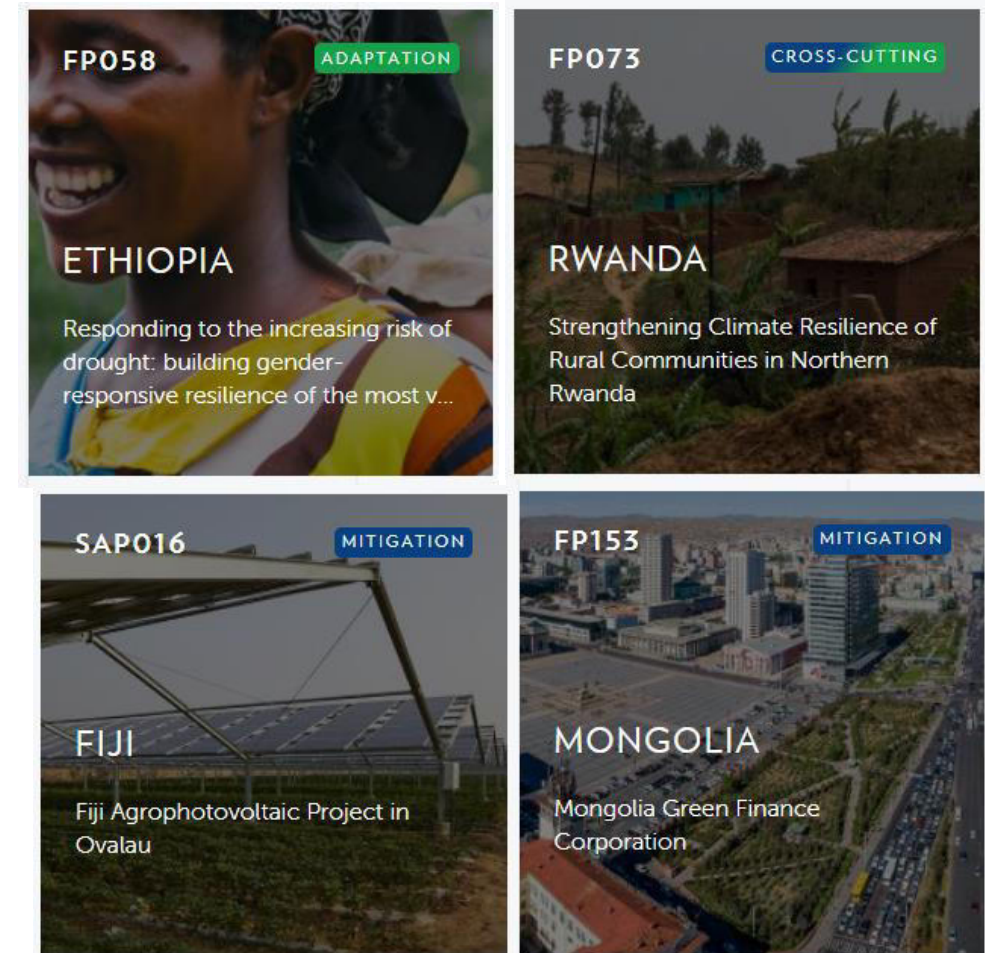


Support for GCF funding proposal development

For countries to access climate finance from the GCF, GGGI supports the development of funding proposals:

- five of which worth USD247 million have already been approved (for Ethiopia, Fiji, Indonesia, Mongolia and Rwanda); and
- three in the GCF pipeline (for Peru, Indonesia, and regional for SE Asia – Cambodia, Laos, Thailand, Philippines and Vietnam).

GGGI has also supported the development of concept notes for Burkina Faso, Cote d'Ivoire, Fiji, Guyana, Indonesia, Jordan, Lao PDR, Mexico, Nepal, Philippines, Rwanda and Vanuatu. **In most of these projects, GGGI works with national direct access entities.** The total value of these projects is over USD 1 billion.



GGGI supports **national** accredited entities on funding proposal development to access GCF funding: USD 143 million approved, with Ethiopia's Ministry of Finance and Economic Cooperation; Rwanda's Ministry of Environment; Fiji Development Bank; Mongolia's XacBank LLC

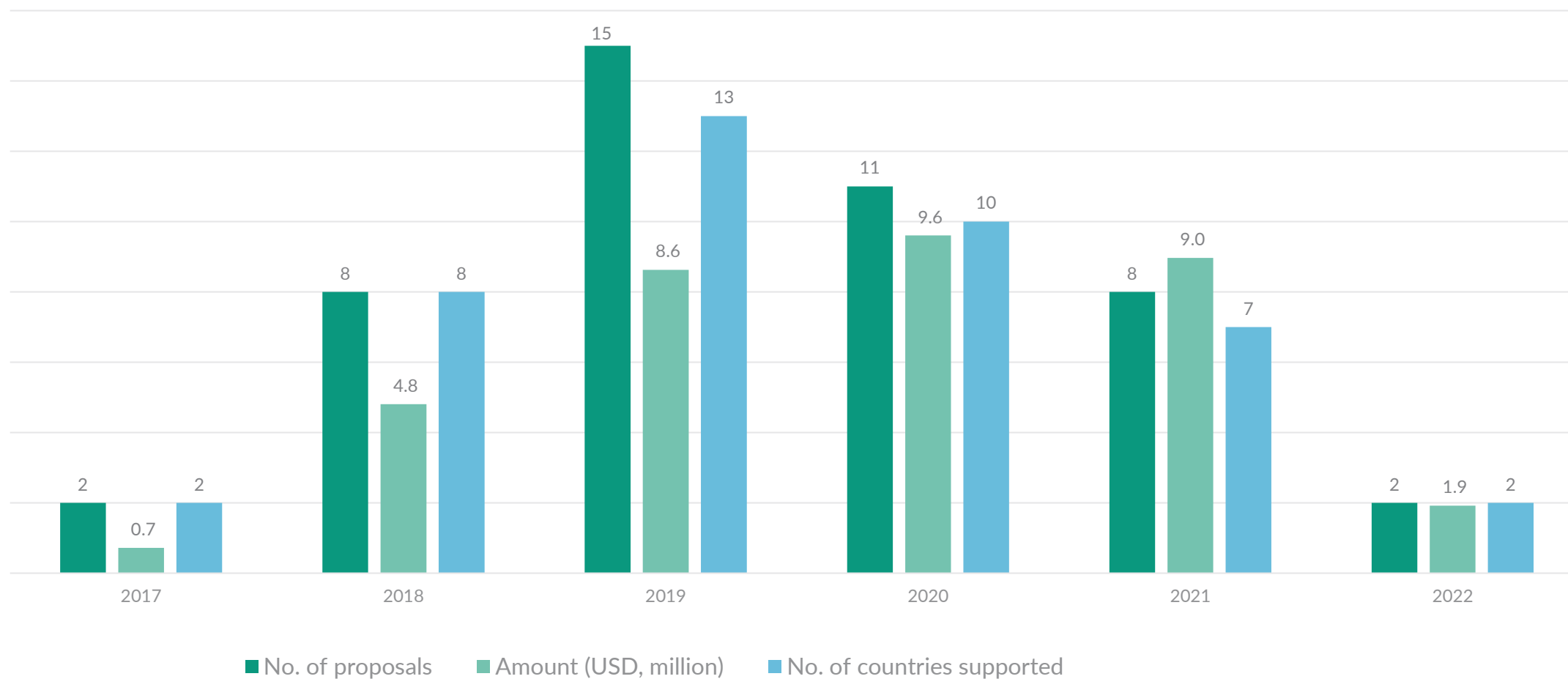
